


How to make an online submission about the proposed Marine Park

1. Type www.marine.nsw.gov.au into your website address bar
2. When the webpage appears on your screen, go to the **Key Initiatives** tab and select the option underneath for **Hawkesbury Shelf marine bioregion assessment** (as shown below)



On this internet page you can access a number of supporting documents to provide you with information about the proposal including the Discussion Paper (Parts 1 and 2), overview map of the proposed marine park, Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's), individual site specific information and more.

3. Scroll down the page, past the map of the proposed marine park until you reach the section titled **Have Your Say**
4. Click on the underlined words within this section showing online submission form (as shown below)

Have Your Say 3

Your comments are sought on the 25 sites comprising the park proposal, the management changes proposed at each site, and/or the benefits and costs to your activities, community or industry.

You can have your say by completing the [online submission form](#) by 27 September 2018.

The information you provide will inform the final marine park proposal to be considered by the NSW Government later in 2018. Existing management rules remain in place, and none of the proposals will be implemented until the NSW Government announces the outcome.

5. You will now be redirected to the survey/submission page at:

6. Read through the information on the Introduction page and then click on the **Next** button at the bottom of the screen.
7. Read through the Privacy page, click the circle to the left of the Yes or No button at the bottom of the screen to confirm whether you want your submission to be confidential or not (which will place a tick in the circle) then click on the **Next** button.
8. The next question (see below) asks for your general view of the proposed marine park.

The proposed marine park in combination with the Marine Estate Management Strategy effectively address the identified priority threats and enhance benefits, in particular marine biodiversity conservation in the bioregion.

Select one of the 5 options listed, by clicking on the circle to the left of the statement (which will place a tick in the circle).

In the box underneath that asks 'Why?', add any comments you would like to make to support your view, then click on the **Next** button.

9. The next page titled 'Marine Park site questions' has the 25 sites listed (as pictured below). You can either select to make comments on an **individual site**, or you can opt to 'Provide **general comment** on the proposed marine park sites or **upload a submission**'.

Please note: if you want to comment on multiple sites, **you can only complete the questions for one site at a time**, as each of the questions are specific to a particular site, and some of the sites (Long Reef, Barrenjoey and Cabbage Tree Bay) also have additional questions relevant only to that site.

10. Once you have selected the site you want to comment on, click on the **Next** button

11. The next page will show you:

- the name of the site you have selected,
- the site objectives,
- a table with the proposed management rules, and
- a set of questions relating to that site.

12. The final question on each 'site' page will ask you to 'select which site you'd like to comment on next or provide general comments' (see below).

For example, if you had chosen to comment on Site 1, you will note the screen above shows all other sites except for Site 1.

For this question, either select:

- Another site, and answer the questions relating to that site
- Provide general comments, which will take you to a page where you can add general comments and upload any supporting documentation
- End survey, which will take you to the 'About You' page to collect some basic data about who you are

13. Once you have answered the 'About You' questions, there are two questions to answer about your experience using the survey.

14. The final 'Thank You' page, has a **Done** button which will submit your responses and complete the survey

Helpful Tips for your submission:

- Questions with an * are compulsory and you cannot continue until you have completed them.
- Until you click **Done** at the end of the survey you are able to return to previous pages and edit your responses. Once you click **Done** you are unable to make any changes.
- **You have the ability to upload attachments on the general comments page.**
