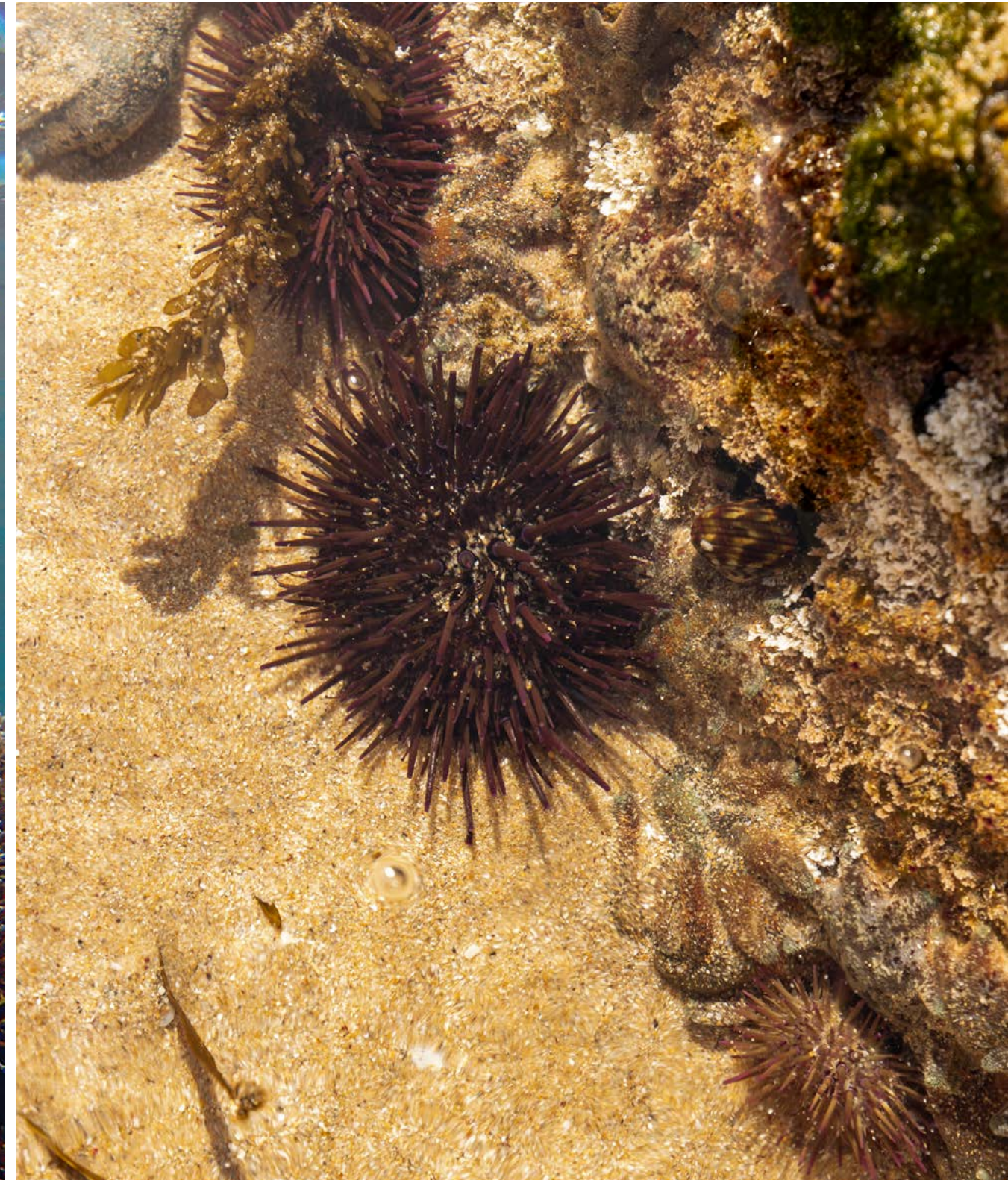
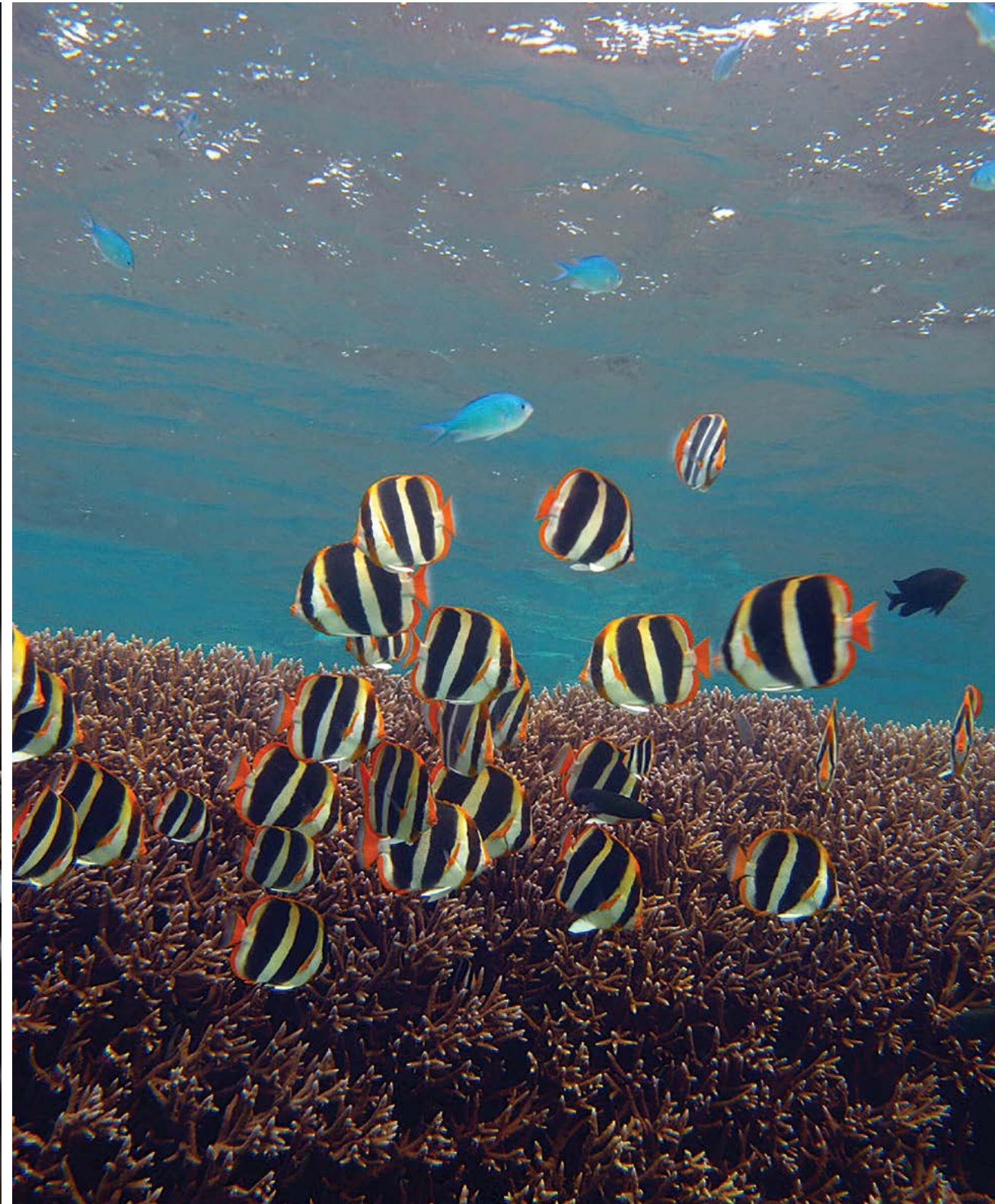

Seagrass



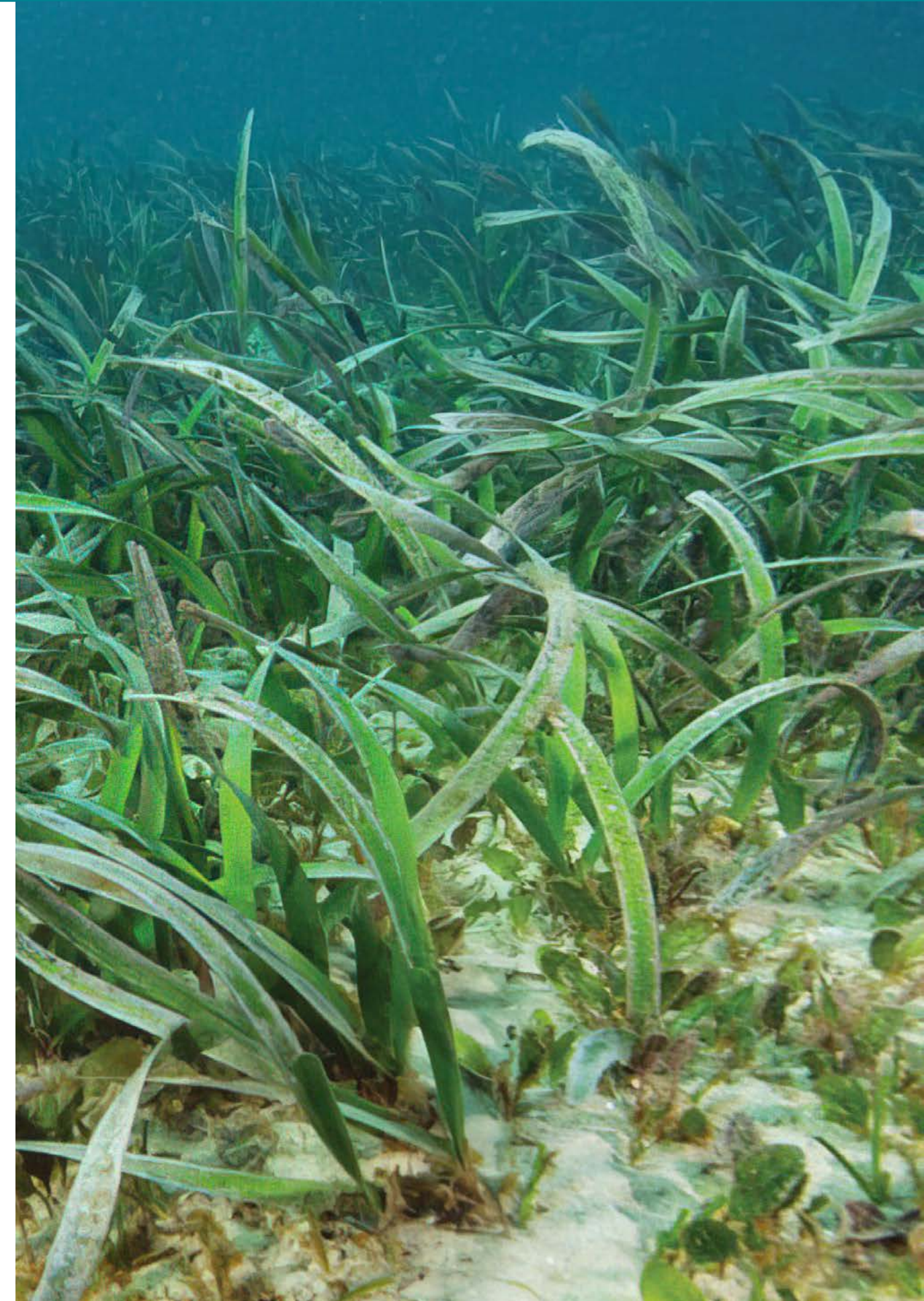

What does seagrass need to survive?

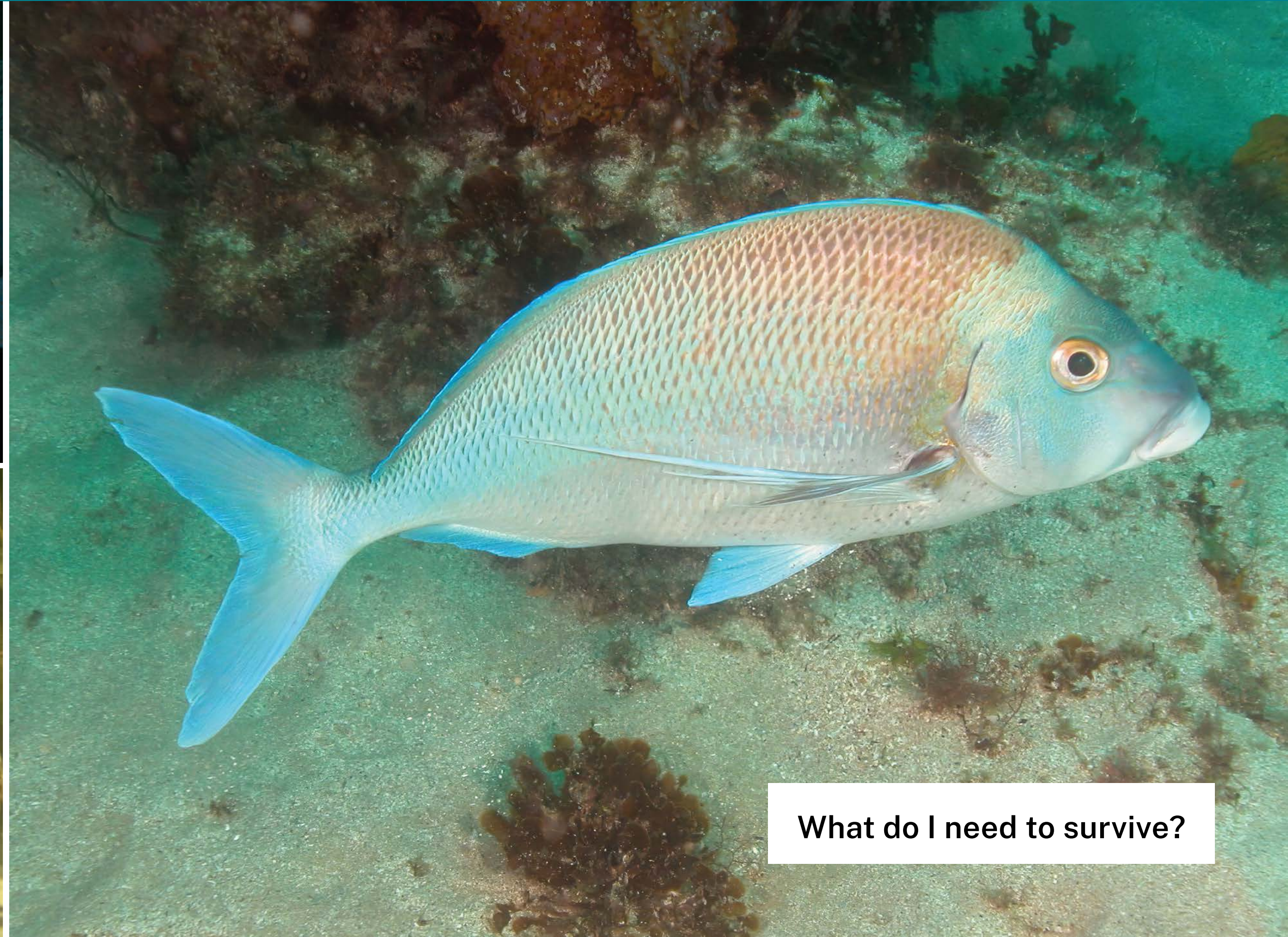
Seagrass needs...

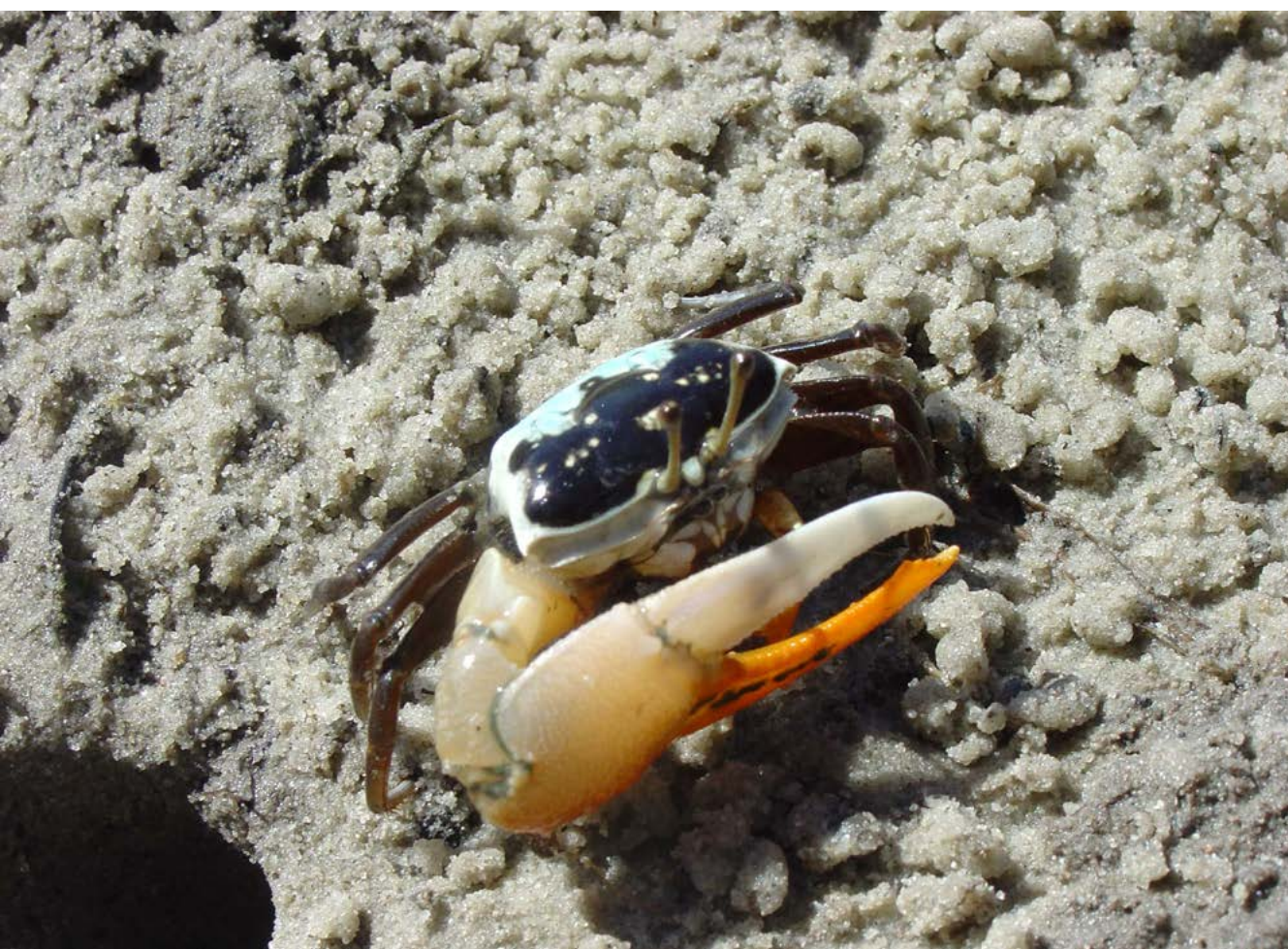
Fish need...

What do birds need to survive?

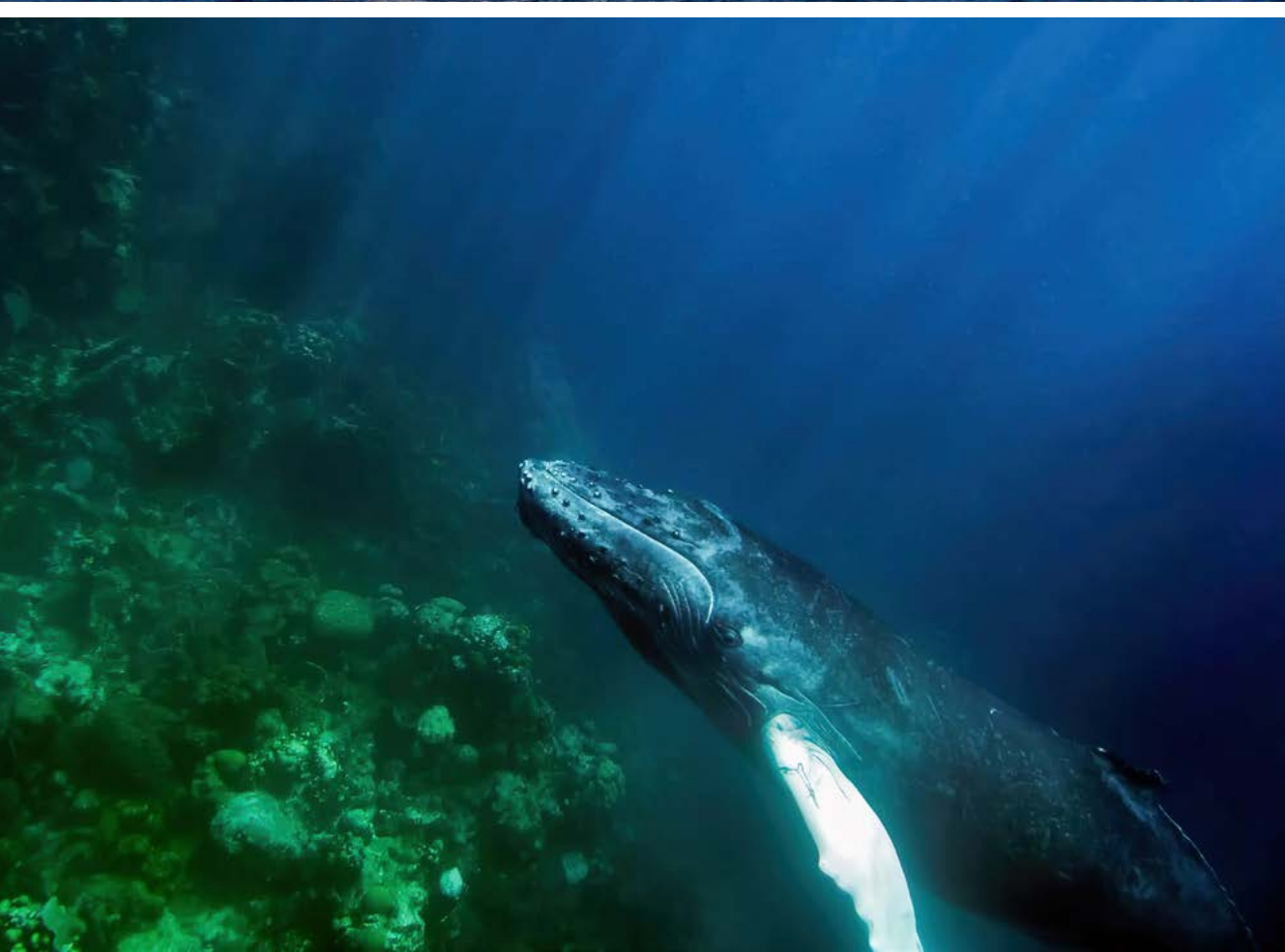
Birds need...

Whales



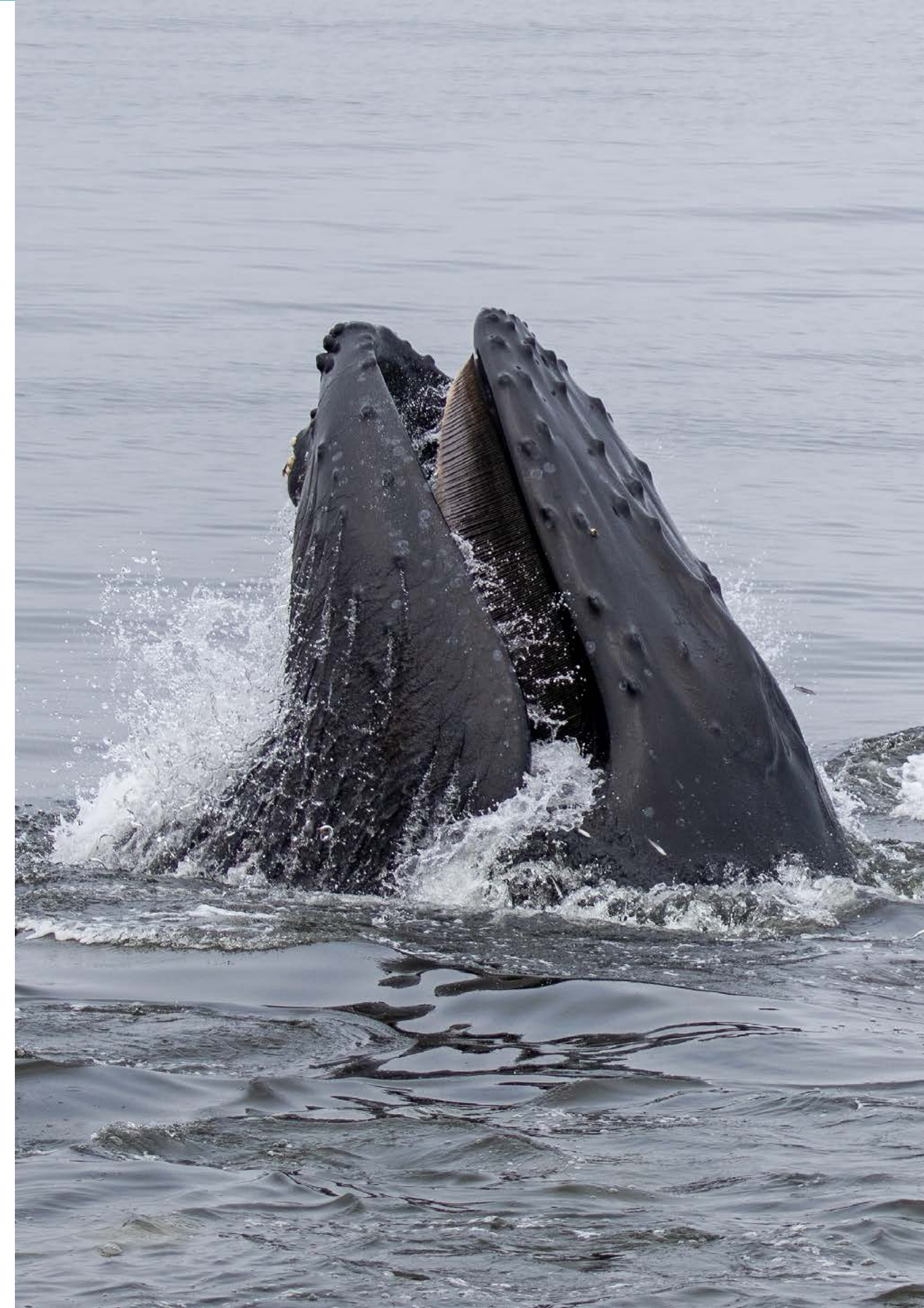

What do whales need to survive?

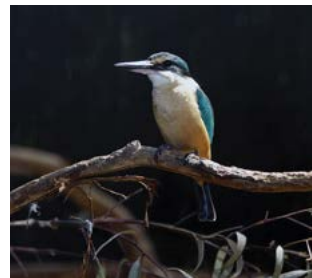
Whales need...

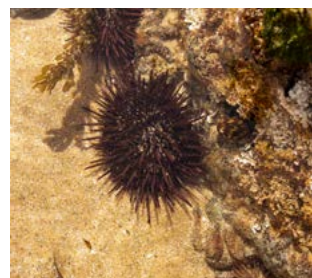

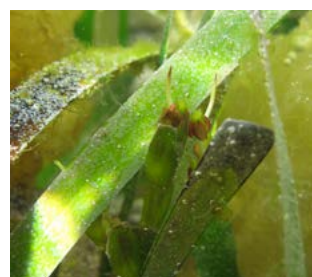

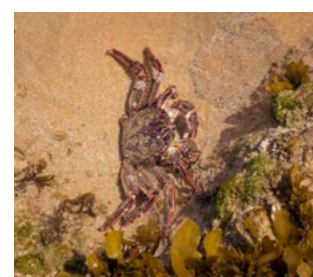
